

UF Unit in Author's Byline:

How to determine inclusion when a publication is based on research performed at another institution

The basic policy is that all publications submitted **must include the UF unit in the author's byline**. It doesn't matter where research was conducted as long as the author's current unit appears as the author's affiliation in the article. Please see the following example, created from: Cicero, J. Cicero's (Figure 1) affiliation in the article is the University of Arizona, so even though his current address is listed as UF, this publication could not be included in this report for him. However it will be included for Jawwad A. Qureshi (Figure 2), whose byline shows his current UF unit.

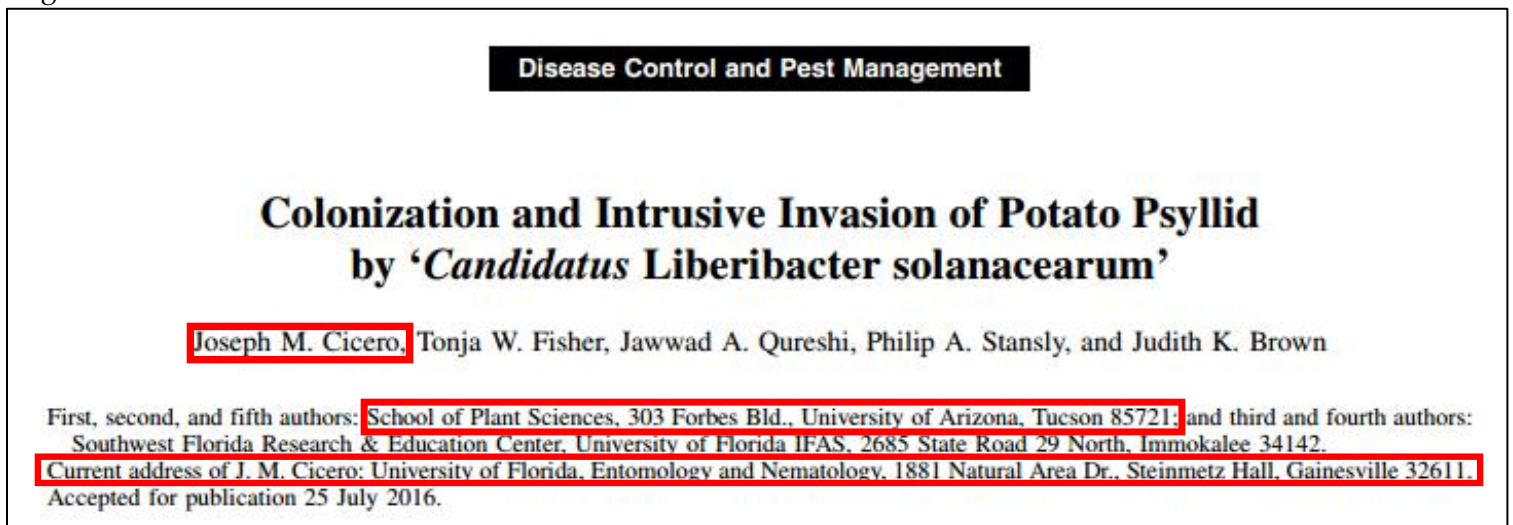
