## All Interested Parties:

The William T. Grant Foundation has announced their 2016-2017 Scholars Program. The Scholars Program is for early-career researchers in the social, behavioral, and health sciences. The program is focused on youth ages 5 to 25 in the United States.

Applicants must have received their terminal degree within seven years of submitting their application and be employed in career-ladder positions. Every year, four to six William T.
