SUBJECT: 2018 FAES Undergraduate Summer Research Internship Program - Request for Faculty Project Submissions

The Florida Agricultural Experiment Station (FAES) is again sponsoring a summer research intern program. Undergraduate students (juniors and above) in the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences (CALS) will apply to work, and they will be matched with a research faculty member. Faculty advisors will receive \$3,700 to appoint their intern at \$14 per hour for 240 hours (students can work full-time for six weeks or part-time over the summer – this program allows this kind of flexibility).

The intent of this program is to introduce CALS undergraduates to research and future careers in science, with a priority for students who have yet to participate in a paid research experience.

If you are interested in providing a professional work experience on one or more of your REEport Project objectives, please enter the dates, location of employment, 200 word description and brief list of intern duties at our submission site: [here](#). In order to help facilitate the matchmaking process, these descriptions will be available for the students to view online beginning **December 22, 2017**. Students have until January 31, 2018 to apply. Matching will begin immediately with the goal of completion by the end of March.
